**Plea from the Boat Team:**

**The boats versus our kit.**

During our kit maintenance over this winter (or the day before the first dive trip next year if perhaps you leave things until the last minute), can I ask everyone to spend a few minutes checking their equipment for any sharp projections.

In particular some types of pony cylinder brackets use stainless steel jubilee clips to secure the bracket to the cylinder. This leaves the end of the clip sticking out.

During this year we had an unfortunate incident where one of these clips damaged one of the RIB tubes. Fortunately it happened in port and was easily repaired. It was nobodies fault (except perhaps the equipment manufacturers) but can easily be avoided.

The clip either needs to be covered with tape, or even better trimmed off next to the screw. This should still leave enough left to undo it.

Try and get rid of, or reduce any other projections. If they can catch on the boat, they can get caught up on net or fishing line etc.

The more streamlined your kit, the less effort to fin, and the less chance of getting caught both under and above the water.

## Interest Evenings (Over the Last Month)

A couple of interest evenings over the last month.

First, **Dave Goddard** gave us a report of his recent trip to Lake Malawi in Africa (a picture of one of the fish he saw there is on the front cover).

**Jim Tyson** from South West Maritime Archaeology Group gave a talk covering a number of wrecks they have worked on. Their discoveries have covered important sites with a range of artefacts including coins and a range of historical items.

Jim (with the support of his team) gave us the talk explaining how they came across gold coins on a dive on a 'boring old canon site' and how they fully examined the



site and the surrounding area whilst keeping the site and their finds secret from everyone except close family and the Receiver of Wrecks. They eventually ended up with many artefacts and 2lbs 15oz of gold. Ignoring (for a moment) the historical value, then at £1000/oz that's a cool £47K - but don't worry all the coins and artefacts are safe in the British Museum.

An excellent evening and just serves to remind us what we could find on a dive if we are really lucky - and keep our eyes open.

At present we estimate that we will have between 5 and 10 scouts. If any children of current members are interested, please speak to Fran or myself,

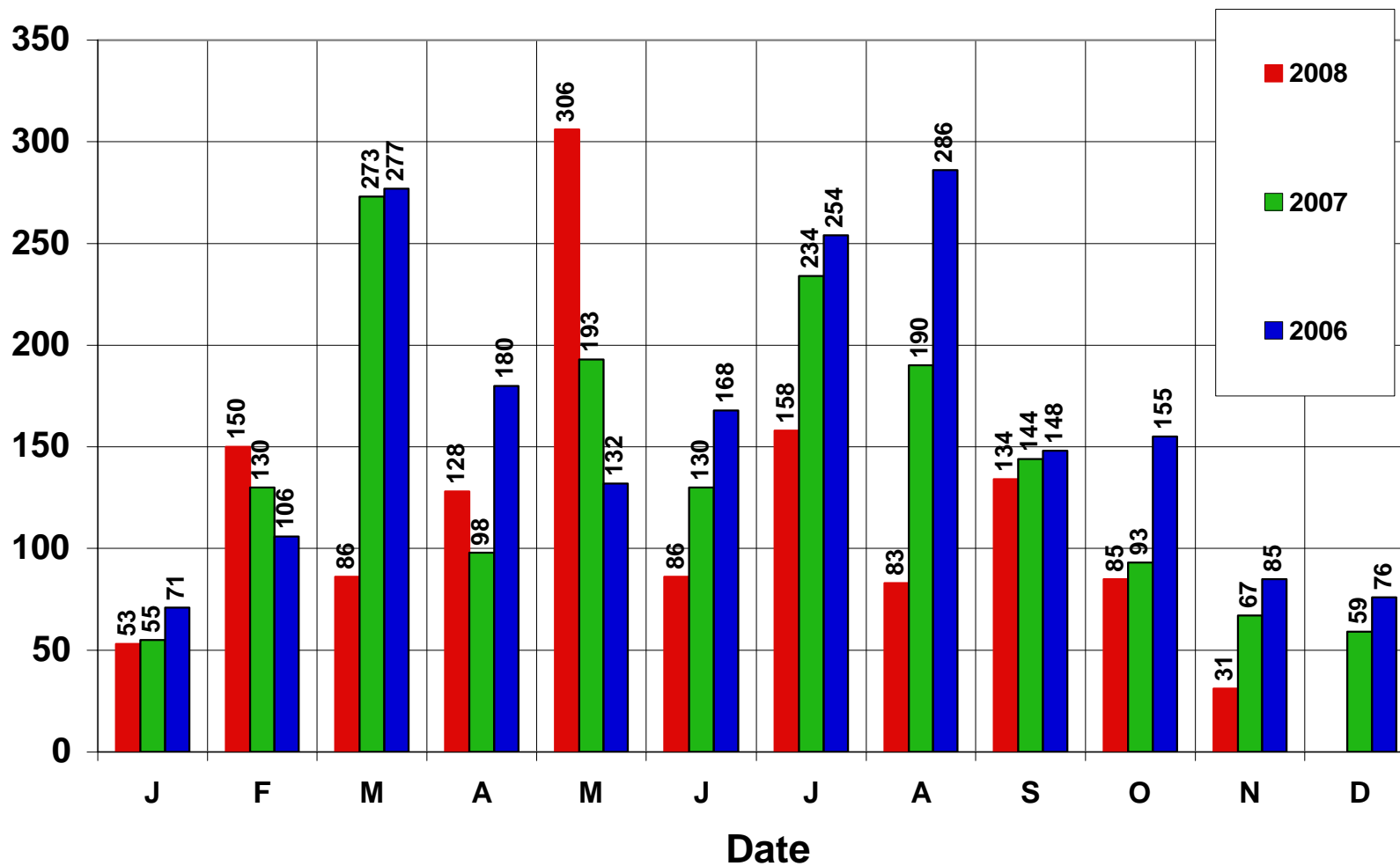
